Action Required	Details	
1.Endorsement	School Principal's L	ter Each public high school in Dasmariñas must formally endorse its Top 10 graduating students. The endorsement letter must be signed by the School Principal and submitted to the DLSU-D Center for Student Admissions (CSA).
2. Application	Online Application	Endorsed students must complete their application online (within the application period, from November 26, 2025- January 12, 2026) through the DLSU-D admissions portal.
3. Fee Waiver	Validation	When filling out the application, students must select "Public School" in the "type of school" field. Once the application is validated against the Principal's endorsement list, the application fee will be automatically waived.
4. Admissions Test	Onsite Examination	Successfully endorsed and registered applicants are scheduled to take the onsite DLSU-D Student Admissions Test (DSAT) on January 17, 2026.
5. Enrollment	Confirmation	Successful applicants who passed the DSAT and meet all admission criteria may then proceed with slot confirmation and enrollment.
