**REVISED GUIDELINES ON ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP
FOR A.Y. 2020-2021**

1. No application shall be needed for this scholarship type.
2. Students should not have a grade lower than 3.25 in all subjects, must be enrolled with a minimum of 18 units subject load, and with one semester residency to be considered as potential academic scholar.
3. The Office of the University Registrar shall provide the list of top 30 students, determined based on the grade point average (GPA) up to the fourth decimal place.
4. The following tuition* discounts shall be given:
 - a. Top 1 – 5 - 100% ;
 - b. Top 6 – 10 - 75% ;
 - c. Top 11 – 15 - 50% ;
 - d. Top 16 – 20 - 25% ; and
 - e. Top 21 – 30 - 10%(**Tuition excludes miscellaneous, laboratory, and other fees*)
5. An academic scholar shall be allowed to apply for another internally funded scholarship. However, s/he can only choose one scholarship type.
6. The academic scholars shall be notified thru DLSU-D Student Portal.
