# SFAG

The **Student Financial Aid Grant (SFAG)** scholarship supports **College** students. Accepted grantees will render duty hours in their assigned office, with their hours based on their scholarship percentage.



# ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP



The **Entrance Scholarship** offers financial aid to deserving Grade 7, Grade 11 and Freshmen students who have ranked **first** and **second** belonging to a batch of at least 100 graduates from any DepEd recognized schools.

There are also **other scholarships** that students may apply for; however, their respective offices are responsible for the application and evaluation processes:

## INTERNALLY FUNDED

Performing Arts Group, Heraldo Filipino, POLCA Office, Student Government Grants, Varsity, NROTC, EBSP, etc.

## EXTERNALLY FUNDED

Government-Funded Scholarship, Foundation Scholars, etc.



# Qualification-Based

*These are internal scholarships that do not follow the standard application process and are solely based on its following criteria.*



## ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

The **Academic Scholarship** is given to upperclassmen whose GPA ranks in the **top 30% of a particular semester**, calculated up to the 4th decimal place using records provided by the **Office of the Registrar**. Discount percentage varies based on the student's ranking.



## EBPSP

The **Enhanced Brother President Scholarship Program (EBPSP)** provides scholarships to the legal dependents of employees of **De La Salle University-Dasmariñas (DLSU-D)** and **De La Salle Medical and Health Sciences Institute (DLSMHSI)**.



## ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP

The **Athletic Scholarship** is awarded to **recruited varsity players** who demonstrate commitment to both sports and academics. Covered sports include Basketball, Volleyball, Athletics (Track & Field), Badminton, Table Tennis, Swimming, and Chess.



## PD 577 SCHOLARSHIP

The **PD 577 Scholarship** is a government-mandated educational assistance program that grants tuition and matriculation fee exemptions to **qualified dependents of military personnel who died or became permanently incapacitated** in the line of duty.

# Merit-Based

*These are internal scholarships awarded to students who have demonstrated exceptional performance in both academic and extracurricular activities.*



The **Vicissitude Office** at DLSU-D empowers students in the **yearbook production**, promoting responsibility, creativity, and service. Outstanding members of the Editorial Board (EB) and Editorial Staff (ES) will receive scholarship discounts based on their performance, alongside other organizational benefits.



The **Performing Arts Group (PAG)** offers scholarship opportunities for students with exceptional skills and a passion for singing, dancing, acting, and playing musical instruments.



The **NROTCU scholarship** was granted under the provision stated in the Student Handbook section 17.1.4, which allows for tuition discounts for various groups including ROTC officers. Deserving ROTC officers may receive up to 100% scholarship grant based on the provision.



The **DLSU-D Alumni Association Scholarship** is a financial assistance program funded by alumni donations and partnerships that helps deserving students of De La Salle University-Dasmariñas continue their Lasallian education despite financial challenges.



The **POLCA Scholarship** is a financial assistance program funded by the Parent Organization of La Salle Cavite that supports deserving students of De La Salle University-Dasmariñas who demonstrate academic merit and financial need.



The **Student Government Scholarship Grants** is a financial assistance program funded by the different college student government units that supports deserving students of De La Salle University-Dasmariñas based on academic performance, leadership involvement, and financial need.
