Subject: **OCM 038: CONTINGENCIES ON THE IMPENDING SUPER TYPHOON**

The University Community is advised of the following should suspension of classes be declared by any official government agency (local or national) for 26 May or 27 May:

1. All scheduled events and activities (online and onsite) will be immediately suspended.
2. The University will be immediately closed. Only identified personnel will be permitted entry.
3. Nevertheless, ConTReNDS 2023, our online conference, will proceed as scheduled tomorrow, 26 May 2023, to conclude officially its proceedings from 8.00 am to 12.00 pm. This is following the request of the majority of participants.
4. Similarly, the Second International Conference on Values and Religious Education, also an online conference, will proceed as scheduled from 26 to 28 May 2023 via Zoom.

In the absence of an official declaration of suspension issued by any official government agency for 26 May or 27 May, the following are observed:

1. Scheduled online activities (conferences, meetings, seminars) may proceed if electricity/internet connections are not disrupted.
2. WFH arrangement shall be observed at all offices at Ayuntamiento de Gonzalez and all academic departments and service offices.
3. Classes shall be rolled out in asynchronous mode. This mode ensures that students avoid travel and stay safe at their homes.
4. For scheduled activities concerning our CBAA, CCJE, CEAT, CLAC, and CSCS, Graduate Studies, your respective official FB groups will issue pertinent postings as regards office operations and activities.

We request everyone to monitor our University website and platforms for serial updates on the super typhoon.
