OVERALL MECHANICS

ELIGIBILITY

- The TAKSAY 2025 Sportsfest is open to all registered Night College students and alumni.
- Only the players listed on the approved official list of players are eligible to play in each tournament.

UNIFORM

- Each team must wear their official team uniform during every game.
- Same shirt is required, but the team identification will be the handkerchief or bandana.
- The handkerchief or bandana may be worn anywhere on the body, as long as it is clearly visible.
- Any player not in complete/proper team uniform shall not be allowed to play.







OVERALL MECHANICS

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Athletes, coaches, and team officials under the influence of alcoholic drinks shall not be allowed to participate.
- Athletes involved in fighting or any grave unsportsmanlike conduct shall be disqualified from further participation.
- Athletes, coaches, or team officials using derogatory or profane language, making obscene gestures, or cursing referees/officials during or after the game will be sanctioned or subjected to disciplinary actions.

GENERAL REMINDERS WHAT TO WEAR

TEAM IDENTIFIER

All players must wear their designated handkerchief or bandana, which should be clearly visible and may be worn anywhere on the body.

NEW NC SHIRT

The New NC Shirt will serve as part of the uniform for all players

JERSEY

Official team jerseys must be worn during every game

SHORTS

Proper athletic shorts must be worn.

RUBBER SHOES

Athletic shoes suitable for the sport being played.

COMPRESSION WEAR

(optional)

Compression sleeves, leggings, and other gear for support and performance enhancement.







GENERAL REMINDERS WHAT NOT TO WEAR

HATS/CAPS

Not allowed unless they are part of the official uniform and approved for the specific sport.

SLIPPERS

Slippers or any open-toed footwear are not allowed.

CROCS OR SIMILAR FOOTWEAR

Rubber clogs and similar styles that lack proper foot support are not permitted.

JEWELRY

Rings, necklaces, earrings, and other jewelry that could pose a safety risk

JEANS

Jeans or any denim clothing are strictly prohibited.

OTHER NON-ATHLETIC WEAR

Any clothing that is not conducive to sports activities, such as casual or formal attire, is not allowed.







ALLOWED TO BRING



IDENTIFICATION CARD

School ID or any valid ID for verification purposes.



SUNSCREEN

Protection from the sun, especially for outdoor events.



MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

Issued by the University Clinic or external source for alumni



BAG

To carry all personal items and equipment.



WATER BOTTLE

To stay hydrated throughout the event.



SNACKS

Healthy snacks for energy between matches.



TOWEL

For personal hygiene and to keep dry during and after games.



FIRST AID KIT

Basic first aid supplies for minor injuries.



CHANGE OF CLOTHES

Extra set of clothes for after games.



PERSONAL MEDICATIONS

Any necessary personal medications.







NOT ALLOWED TO BRING



ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Strictly prohibited on the premises.



EXPLOSIVES

Firecrackers, fireworks, or any explosive materials.



ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES

Any form of illegal drugs or substances.



GLASS CONTAINERS

Glass bottles or containers that can break and cause injury.



WEAPONS

Any type of weapons, including knives, firearms, or any dangerous items.



PETS

Animals are not allowed, with the exception of service animals.





GARBAGE DISPOSAL

- Please ensure that all garbage is disposed of in the designated bins.
- Separate recyclables from non-recyclables according to the labeled bins.
- Keep the event area clean by disposing of trash properly and promptly.
- Avoid littering to maintain a clean and pleasant environment for everyone.
- Report any overflowing bins to event staff.
- Help minimize waste by reducing, reusing, and recycling whenever possible.







SPORTS MECHANICS





BASKETBALL

- Teams will be composed of at least eleven (11) players as determined prior to the tournament.
- The objective of the game is to accumulate points by shooting the ball through the hoop. The team with the most number of points shall be declared as the winner.
- The competition will follow the amateur rules.
- Each game will be composed of 4 quarters having 8 minutes per quarter with (1) minute-break between quarters, except for the half-time break which will be three (3) minutes long.
- The championship game will be composed of 4 quarters
 having 10 minutes per quarter with 1-minute breaks between
 quarters, except for the half-time break which will be three (3)
 minutes long.
- Two 30 second time-outs are allowed for each quarter in both the elimination rounds and championship rounds. The clock will stop during time-outs and at all whistles.
- Games will be scheduled on a tournament basis. The winners of each game will advance to the next round until there is only one final game.





BADMINTON

- Each team will consist of at least five (5) players.
- Players will be divided into singles, doubles, and mixed doubles events.
- Each player can participate in a maximum of two (2) events.
- Matches will be played in singles (men and women), doubles (men and women), and mixed doubles categories.
- Each game will be played to 30 points, with a court change at 15 points.
- Standard badminton rules will apply.
- Each match will be the best of three games.
- If the score reaches 29-29, the game continues until one player/team leads by 2 points or one player/team reaches 31 points.
- There will be a 10-minute break after each game.
- Players should use proper badminton rackets and shuttlecocks.
- Proper badminton shoes are required.
- Matches will be scheduled on a knockout basis. Winners of each match will advance to the next round until a champion is determined.





AMAZING RACE

- Each group must have a minimum of eleven (11) members.
- Each station will have up to 2 assigned facilitators.
- There will be a total of 15 stations.
- Each team will receive a paper indicating the order of stations they must complete.
- Each team will have a different set order to avoid crowding at any station.
- The time taken by each team to complete the task at each station will be recorded by the facilitators.
- After completing all 15 stations, the total time spent by each team at each station will be calculated.
- The team with the least total time will be announced as the winner during the Awarding Ceremony.





CHESS

- The tournament will follow a Double Elimination format.
- Players will compete under a Win and Loss Bracket system, allowing one chance for recovery after a loss. This format is categorized as Rapid Chess, which is faster than classical games but slower than blitz.
- Each player is given 30 minutes to complete all their moves.
- The maximum duration of a match is 60 minutes.
- No time increment is allowed (30|0 time control, no additional time per move).
- Players alternate turns, and the clock runs only when it is a player's turn.
- A player wins by checkmating the opponent's king or by the opponent resigning.
- A player loses by having their time run out (flagged), by checkmating their own king, or by resigning.





VOLLEYBALL

- Teams will be composed of at least ten (10) players.
- Substitution rules apply.
- The objective of the game is to accumulate points by hitting the ball over the net and landing it on the opposing team's court. The team with the most number of points shall be declared as the winner.
- The competition will follow the amateur rules.
- Each game is a best of 3 sets match. The first 2 sets will be up to 21 points while the 3rd set will be up to 15 points only.
- The championship game is a best of 5 sets match, subject to changes depending on time constraints. The first 4 sets will be up to 21 points while the 5th set will be up to 15 points only. However, the committee may decide to make the championship game a best of 3 sets match, following the same rules as the elimination round, making sure that such a fact is communicated to the players prior to the start of the championship game.
- Games will be scheduled on a tournament basis, thus the winners of each game will advance to the next round until there is only one final game.
