

## **MOVING UP EXERCISES AND RECOGNITION CEREMONIES**

**4<sup>th</sup> Moving – Up Exercises (Grade 10)**  
**Assembly Time: 8:00am**

**5<sup>th</sup> Recognition Ceremonies (Grades 8 -9)**  
**Assembly time: 2:00pm**

### **GUIDELINES**

- a) Students should be on time. Late comers should line with the last section throughout the processional and shall be coordinated with designated ushers for the appropriate time to join their section for the awarding.
- b) Doors will be closed after the processional and will be opened after the singing of the Philippine National Anthem.
- c) Strictly only 2 seats are reserved per student. Only parents or guardian are allowed to enter. Parents or guardian should wear the official ribbon upon entry and during the program. No children below 7 years old will be allowed to enter the venue.
- d) Students should wear proper school uniform with sublay for Grade 10 completers and school uniform for awardees of Grades 8 – 9. (No wearing of IDs)
- e) Girls: Proper Hair Style, no headress and with or without light make – up
- f) Boys: Wear proper haircut, no earrings.
- g) Food or drinks are not allowed inside the venue.
- h) Proper decorum should be maintained in the observance of a formal occasion.
  - h.1 Howling, shouting, whistling, cheering and cat calling are not allowed. Applaud cheerly and gracefully.
  - h.2. Doing fancy peer gesture during the program should be avoided.
- i) Students are not allowed to use personal gadgets and cellphones during the ceremony.
- j) Pictures during the ceremony will be taken by the official photographers only.
- k) Student should be seated on their designated place only.
- l) Students are not allowed to go outside the venue and should stay until the end of the program.
- m) Ingress of private vehicles is at Gate 3 and egress it at Gate 4. No drop off/pick up in the ULS.
- n) Proper dress code should be observed.
- o) No pets allowed.
- p) No smoking and no vehicle idling
