## Application for Academic Scholarship 1<sup>st</sup> Semester and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester A.Y. 2018-2019

- I. General Policy
  - The Scholarship Grant is open to all Grade 11 (2<sup>nd</sup> semester) and Grade 12 students (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester) of DLSU-D Senior High School.
  - 2. Academic scholarship applicants must have:
    - For Grade 11
      - 2.1 Passed all subjects taken during the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of A.Y. 2018-2019.
      - **2.2** A **General Average of at least 95 and no final average below 90** (Transmuted Grade) in any of their subjects from the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of A.Y. 2018-2019.

## For Grade 12

- 2.3 For 1<sup>st</sup> semester of AY 2018-2019, passed all subjects taken during the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of A.Y. 2017-2018.
- **2.4** A General Average of at least 95 and no final average below 90 (Transmuted Grade) in any of their subjects from the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of A.Y. 2017-2018.
- **2.5** For 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of A.Y. 2018-2019, passed all subjects taken during the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of A.Y. 2018-2019.
- **2.6** A **General Average of at least 95 and no final grade below 90** (Transmuted Grade) in any of their subjects from the **1**<sup>st</sup> **semester of A.Y. 2018-2019**.
- 3. **Twenty (20) scholarship slots** are available for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of A.Y. 2018-2019 for Grade 11 students.

There are also **twenty (20) scholarship slots** for Grade 12 students for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of A.Y. 2018-2019 and **twenty (20) scholarship slots** for Grade 12 students for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of A.Y. 2018-2019.

- The top five students will receive 100% scholarship grant, the students who ranked 6-10 will receive 75% scholarship, the students who ranked 11-15 will receive 50% scholarship, and the last five (16-20) will receive 25% scholarship. The rank will be determined during the deliberation.
- 5. The Scholarship grant shall only apply to the <u>tuition fee for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of A.Y.</u> <u>2018-2019</u>. Miscellaneous and other fees shall be paid by the student.
- 6. The Scholarship grant is only applicable for <u>one semester</u>. Grantees may re-apply for the succeeding semesters, provided that they still meet all the criteria.

## II. Application Policies and Procedures

1. **Deadline of submission of Application for Scholarship**, together with the required documents, is on **January 31, 2019, 5:00 pm** at the **Senior High School Office**. Applications with incomplete documents shall not be processed.

- 2. The Academic Scholarship Form is available for download on the **DLSU-D website** and a hard copy of the form is available at the **Senior High School Office**.
- 3. The filled out Academic Scholarship Application Form and the required supporting documents shall be placed into a <u>short colored plastic envelope</u> (yellow for STEM, red for HUMSS/ABM, blue for TVL/ICT).

For Grade 12 students qualified for Scholarship grant for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semesters, they must submit two application forms—one for 1<sup>st</sup> semester and one for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. Both forms and supporting documents shall be placed in one plastic envelope.

- 4. List of scholarship grantees will be released through official communication channels (Senior High School Facebook Page, Bulletin Boards, DLSU-D official website, Schoolbook).
- 5. The grantee must present the <u>printed Certificate of Registration (COR) to the Chair of the Senior High School Scholarship Committee</u>. The grantee will be issued a <u>Confirmation Slip</u> which should be duly signed by the Scholarship Committee Chair and the Asst. Director for Senior High School and Director for Basic Education.
- 6. The grantee's COR, with the Confirmation Slip, must be presented to the Accounting Office for re-assessment of fees after the scholarship grant.
- 7. The corresponding fees must be paid as indicated at the Accounting Office and/or the accredited payment centers.
- 8. In case the student has already paid the tuition fee in full before the qualified scholars are announced, DLSU-D will refund the amount that corresponds to the tuition discount. The student can also opt to have the amount deducted from his/her tuition fee for the succeeding semesters, if applicable.
- 9. Scholarship grantees must have a Midterm Grade of at least 90 in all of their subjects for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of A.Y. 2018-2019.
