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REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

**AS PAPER PRESENTER (Non-DLSU-D Students)

- The De La Salle University-Dasmariñas High School Research Fair 2021 is open to all researchers who are currently enrolled as high school students (Grade 10, 11, and 12) within and outside Cavite. Interested presenters should register first in the Eventbrite link: <u>http://bit.ly/3kS02Hq</u>
- 2) Submission of entries will be from March 31, 2021 until April 24, 2021. All submissions will undergo a blind selection process. Researchers are encouraged to submit papers that fall in any of the following categories:
 - Arts, Culture, and Cavite Studies
 - Climate and Disaster Studies
 - Natural Products, Food Security, Product and Enterprise Development
 - Ecotourism, Environment and Sustainability
 - Mental Health and Filipino Psychology
 - Filipino Philosophy and the Sociology of New Normal
 - Lasallian Studies
 - Life Sciences
 - Gender Studies and Development
 - Policy Development
 - Robotics and ICT
- 3) A 250-word abstract with the names and academic affiliation of the researchers must be submitted as a PDF file, using the following format: Times New Roman, font size 12. The document must be letter-sized and in portrait orientation. The abstract must be submitted using this link: http://bit.ly/DLSUDHSAbstractSubmission
- 4) A notice of acceptance will be sent to the qualified researchers on April 30, 2021. Afterwards, the selected researchers are requested to submit their full research paper as a PDF file, following the APA 7th edition format.



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5) Details regarding the research conference will be forwarded in a separate email to the qualified presenters. They will also be sent a consent form to acknowledge that their faces and names will be shown during the conference, pursuant to the Data Privacy Act of 2012. Qualified applicants should acknowledge that they are freely consenting to the use of their information throughout the whole program. Organizers will only be using their information for academic purposes and will be disposed of after the event.

**AS CONFERENCE ATTENDEE

- The DLSU-D High School Research Fair is open to students, faculty, and other members of the academic community who only intend to listen to the paper presentations and plenary session. A registration form may be accessed through the Eventbrite link: <u>http://bit.ly/3kS02Hq</u>
- 2. The registration page is divided into two: one for the research presenters and one for the individual participants.
- 3. Participants/attendees must input their full name, academic affiliation, designation, active email address, and active phone number so that they may be contacted by the organizers for the other details regarding the event.
- 4. Registrants will receive a confirmation email which contains information regarding the event.
- 5. Since the research conference will entirely be done online, the registration for both participants and presenters is FREE OF CHARGE.



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RESEARCH CONFERENCE EVENTS

The research conference is divided into three (3) events that the participants can join in as an audience member or as a presenter:

- A. **Plenary Session**: The DLSU-D High School Research Fair will begin with a plenary session where invited speakers who are experts in their respective fields will share their stories and knowledge to student-researchers and other guests. The general aim of this plenary session is to address the ever-changing field of research and inspire students to further strengthen their research skills and academic abilities for the benefit of themselves, the academe, and the community.
- B. Paper Presentations: This event is where DLSU-D and non-DLSU-D high school students will be able to share their research topics and findings to contribute to their fields. Paper presentations will be divided based on theme and the guests may choose where they would serve as audience members. Paper presentations are exclusively for high school students only to recognize their skills and knowledge and be able to train competent groups of researchers who will be able to pursue important roles in the academic and research field someday.
- C. **Poster Presentations**: This event will be for DLSU-D Grade 12 students who are enrolled in Inquiries, Investigation, and Immersion (I3) and Capstone subjects. Poster presentations will exhibit the innovative and collaborative products and concepts of DLSU-D high school students who came from different tracks. This event aims to highlight the relevance of their outputs to their specific track and the importance of their findings to their future careers.



AWARD CATEGORIES

The Research Fair will acknowledge exemplary students through these award categories. Recipients of the award will receive certificates and medals. These award categories are open to both DLSU-D and non-DLSU-D high school students and will be judged by esteemed university professors who are not affiliated with DLSU-D High School to ensure fairness and reliability.

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Best Paper Presenter – This category aims to acknowledge researchers who displayed exemplary presentation and discussion skills. Researchers must be able to present their study skillfully and enthusiastically, while making their research topic understandable to the audience regardless of their academic background or strand.

Best Research Paper – This category aims to acknowledge research papers that exhibited high academic quality from the inception, literature review, methodology, and discussion of findings. Research papers must reflect the researchers' level of knowledge and adeptness when it comes to the field of study. This category will also measure the relevance and potential contribution of the submitted research papers in the academic field.
