The Linkages and Scholarship Office is pleased to announce its newly established awards for the DLSU-D students and student organization who initiates efforts relative to internationalization. This has come to life as the university continuously complies with CHEd Memorandum 55 S. 2016: Policy Framework and Strategies on the Internationalization of Philippine Higher Education that encourages all HEIs in the country to engage in various international activities such as conferences, trainings, partnerships and collaborations, academic exchange programs, cultural camps, international competitions, and other forms of engagements where the presence of international perspective is evident.

Thus, the following shall serve as *\*additional awards* for the annual Luntiang Parangal organized by the good Office of Student Services:

**A. OUTSTANDING STUDENT ORGANIZATION ENGAGED IN IZN PROGRAMS.** This award is given to a student organization of the university who has active efforts and initiatives in conducting internationalization activities. Said activities shall include but not limited to conferences, fora, trainings, cultural camps, or any student activity in collaboration with foreign organizations/institutions, among others. To receive the award, the student organization shall submit a documentation report to the Linkages and Scholarship Office one month before the Luntiang Parangal awarding. The following shall serve as criteria for judging:

BAYANIHAN STUDENT LEADER OF THE YEAR.** This award is given to the most outstanding officer of Bayanihan (International Student Organization) who exemplifies great leadership to the organization. To receive the award, he/she shall be nominated upon opening the call of the Linkages and Scholarship Office, while the proof of leadership engagement must be submitted one month before the Luntiang Parangal awarding. The following shall serve as criteria for judging:
