The University as it complies with two CHED memoranda (CMO 06 S. 2023: Policies and Guidelines for the Grant of Autonomous and Deregulated Status for the Private Higher Education Institution and CMO 55 S. 2016: Policy Framework and Strategies on the Internationalization of Philippine Higher Education) vis-à-vis the roles and functions of the Linkages and Scholarship Office provide beneficial and sustainable partnerships among local and global institutions, industries, research organizations, government and non-government agencies, communities, among others. Thus, for the university to position itself in the global stage, internationalization is one of its major directions.

DLSU-D's Linkages and Scholarship Office operated under the Office of the Vice President for Global Engagement and External Relations shall support the Office of Student Services in realizing the university's vision to further capacitate student organizations and performing arts groups in providing financial subsidies to join the competition in the international stage. Thus, to better perform this endeavor, the Linkages and Scholarship Office shall have the following guidelines:

1. Recognized Student Organizations and Performing Arts Groups are entitled to apply for the subsidy.
2. Availment per organization is once in every school year.
3. The subsidy shall only be used for international competition which can cover airfare, accommodation, land transportation, refreshments, and other logistical expenses.
4. To avail of the grant, a copy of the project proposal must be transmitted to the Linkages Office two months prior to the conduct of the activity. It should contain the following:
 - a. Project Title/Competition
 - b. Proponent/s
 - c. Nature of the competition
 - d. Date of the competition
 - e. Project Brief which includes the benefit it will provide to the university (300-500-word description)
5. Three slots shall be allocated per school year.
6. The Linkages Office shall communicate with the proponent/s regarding the approval and release of the grant.
7. Proper liquidation should must be accomplished one week after arrival.
