
≻ Validity

Academic **Scholarship**

> Who are qualified?

- ✓ Top 54 students from the (7) colleges with the highest GPA based on the records provided by the OUR (Office of the University Registrar)
- ✓ No grades lower than 3.25 in all subjects
- ✓ Must be enrolled with a minimum of 18 units subject load
- ✓ With one (1) semester residency





> Who are qualified?

- Must be a Filipino citizen, preferably Catholic, with good moral character; and preferably a graduate of a public school
- ✓ With general average of 85% and above for incoming freshmen; and 2.50 GPA for the upperclassmen
- With no failing grades in any other subjects
- Must be enrolled with a minimum of 18 units subject load, or as prescribed by the course curricula
- ✓ Course to be taken must be preferably listed in the priority courses of the University

Accomplish the online scholarship application on specified date set by the office with the following documents attached/uploaded:

- a. Application Letter from parent/guardian to be addressed to: Scholarship Coordinator of DLSU-D;
- b. One (1) recommendation letter either from the guidance counselor, class adviser, subject teacher or school principal;



- c. Personal essay in PDF format with one (1)2x2 photo taken within the last three months;
- d. Certificate of Indigency;
- e. Certificate of Income Tax Return (ITR) or Affidavit of non-filing of ITR or Employment Contract (for children of OFWs);
- f. Copy of previous semester grades/Photocopy of Grade 12 report grades;

SFAG Application Requirements

- g. Certificate of Online Enrollment Registration;
- h. Recent utility (electric and water) bills;
- i. Picture of residence (indoor and outdoor view);
- j. Vicinity sketch map with contact information (please use the official template)

- Tuition Fee excludes miscellaneous, laboratory and other fees)
- Allowed another internally funded scholarship that provides financial assistance not exceeding Php 10,000



- Shall render service hours duty on the assigned office based on the approved grant
- II. Must be a member of Circle of Student Assistants (COSA) and actively participate in COSA activities

III. Must have no failing grades in any subjects and shall maintain a GPA of 2.5 every semester



| 2 nd week of August | Home Visitation |
| 3 rd week of August | Deliberation of the Applicant |
| 4 th week of August | Announcement of Approved Applicant via DLSUD Portal |
