

# SIM REGISTRATION SCAMS

REPORT SCAM



With the government's requirement to register SIM cards, some unscrupulous individuals have sought to take advantage of the situation to illegally acquire subscribers' data. Be wary of the following red flags when registering your SIM.



## Fake pre-registration.

Some unauthorized individuals are sending emails to subscribers prompting them to pre-register their SIM lest it becomes restricted. There are no pre-registrations required by the NTC.

## Fake fees

Some scammers ask for a fee for help in registering the SIM. SIM registration is free for all networks.



## Fake registered SIM cards

SIM cards are registered by the owner after purchase. Do not buy into the idea of pre-registered SIM cards as these may already be compromised or previously used in committing crimes.
