



TIPS TO MAKE SURE YOU'RE USING A SECURE WEBSITE

THE INTERNET CAN BE QUITE A DANGEROUS PLACE IF YOU ARE NOT CAREFUL. DON'T FALL VICTIM TO SCAMS, MALWARES AND VIRUSES WITH THESE PRACTICAL TIPS.

CHECK THE URL

A secure site has a padlock icon beside the website URL to show that it's encrypted with Secure Socket Layer encryption protocols (SSL). It typically starts with https instead of just http.



READ THE WEBSITE'S PRIVACY POLICY

Read through the site's privacy policy and contact information to see how your data is being handled.

SEE IF ITS LEGIT.

Legitimate eCommerce sites usually carry a trust or safety seal to attest to the safety of the site.



USE SECURITY TOOLS

Use web browser tools to block malicious pop ups. You can also check if a link is secure by typing it into Google Safe Browsing.
