🔍 Enable 2-factor authentication

This practice gives you an added layer of protection in case your password is compromised. If a hacker discovers your password, it will be useless without approval from the second factor authentication.

ⓘ Do not share your one-time-password (OTP) over call.

🔍 Don't share confidential information on social media



Don't post information that can be used to verify your identity or snaps of your driver's license, passport, or credit card to protect your account from hacking.

🔍 Don't download pirated software



Pirated software may sometimes come with malicious software (malware) and ransomware that that could damage your files and systems and render them unusable.

What could happen to you

Have your credit card / banking info stolen



Have your identity stolen



Be locked out of your computer for ransom



Have your device used in ad fraud



Have the quality of your work compromised



ⓘ Remember, pirated software is illegal for a reason.
