🔍 Install **anti-virus** and **anti-malware** software ✕

Antivirus and anti-malware protect your devices by destroying viruses and malicious software that cause damage to your files, programs, and operating system.



Always be careful with the programs you install or run. Check the source twice before downloading and installing it.

🔍 Enable **passwords**, **pin codes** and **biometrics** ✕

Pin codes, passwords and biometrics are unique identifiers that protect your data from being compromised by people trying to access your accounts.



Quick Tips to Create Strong Password

- Make long password
- Do not use common phrase
- Use different passwords for different services
- Do not store passwords in the browser
- Use 2-Factor authentication
- Use character combinations
- Use hard to guess security question

🔍 Update your **OS** and **software** ✕

Updates are made on operating systems and other software to fix bugs, improve performance and security. Outdated software are vulnerable to hackers and cybercriminals.



Remember that your computer needs maintenance, just like your car. A well-kept PC can serve you for many years.
