



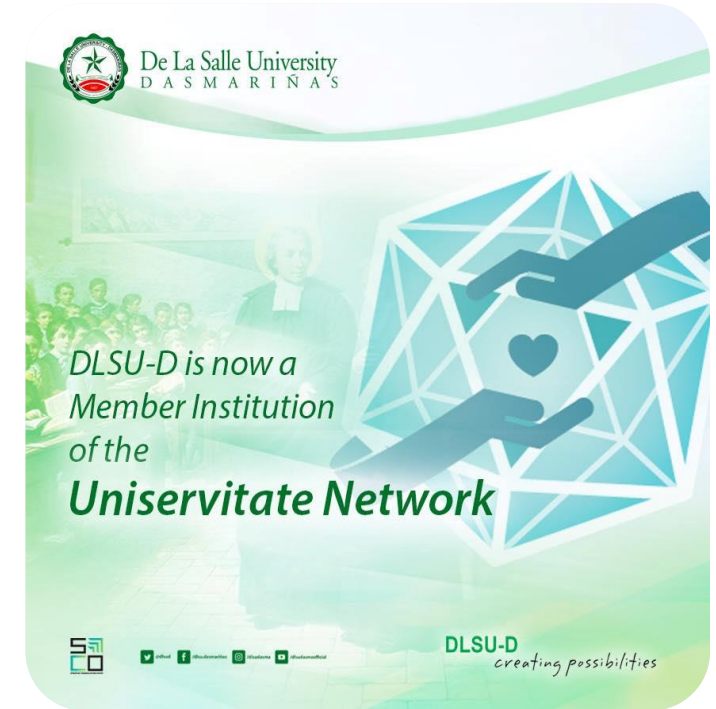

The University was granted memberships in two international organizations such as, ASEAN University Network - Health Promotion Network (AUN-HPN) and Uniservitate Network. As an Associate Member of AUN-HPN, DLSU-D is one with partner universities, committed to fostering academic excellence, promoting research collaboration, and facilitating cultural exchange among member institutions. Meanwhile, as a member of the Uniservitate Network, the University gains access to various benefits, including participation in a global network and learning community of Service-Learning practitioners, access to training resources, eligibility for the Uniservitate Award and research grants, early registration to Uniservitate symposia, exclusive participation in global and regional meetings, as well as meetings among Catholic Higher Education Institutions and community engagement leaders, among other valuable benefits.

The Office of the Vice President for Mission and Formation arranged the visit through Mr. Jose Ritche Bongcaron. Brothers George and John are American Lasallian Brothers who run schools in California, USA.



To further strengthen the international exchange programs between DLSU-D and Taiwan-based schools and universities, a memorandum of agreement has been signed through Dewey International Education Co. Ltd. Mr. Tim Liao, Dewey's President, and Br. Francisco de la Rosa VI FSC, DLSU-D President, sealed the agreement with the expectation of implementing the program in July this year. It hopes to bring in hundreds of Taiwanese students who will take short-term language and culture camps which will be carried out by the university's Language Learning Center.



Seven Lasallian institutions in the country joined the MOU signing initiated by De La Salle Medical and Health Sciences Institute, which aims to bolster local and global partnerships in academics, research, and extension services. The ceremonial signing was attended by various presidents, chancellors, and vice presidents from De La Salle University-Manila, La Salle College-Antipolo, De La Salle-Lipa, De La Salle College of St. Benilde, De La Salle Araneta University, De La Salle Santiago Zobel, and De La Salle University-Dasmariñas. The said multilateral partnerships among De La Salle schools center on curricular innovations, global pedagogies, and research and development.

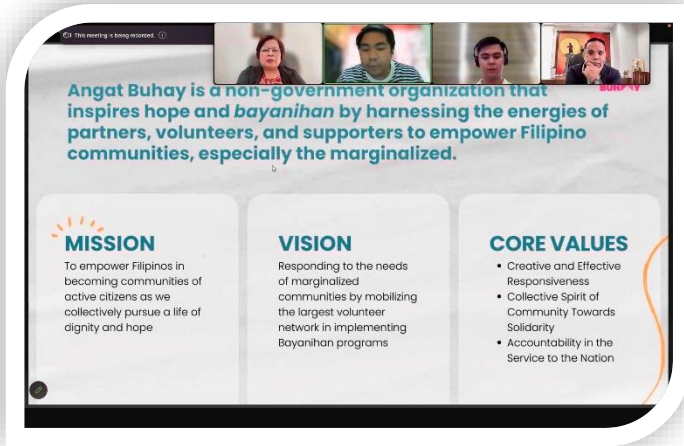

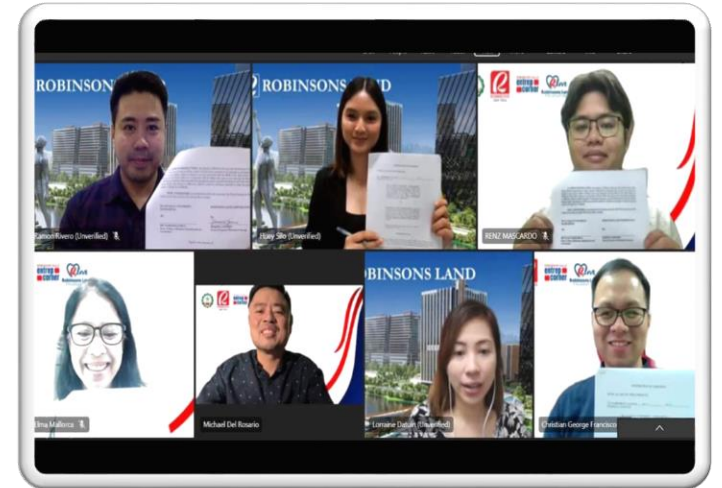
