URO SPEARHEADS FIRST GAWAD TALA FOR RESEARCH

The University Research Office (URO) joined forces with the Human Resources and Management Office (HRMO) to stage the first Gawad Tala research awards in tandem with the university's annual Gawad SINAG.

Formerly titled Gawad Lasalyano sa Pananaliksik, the URO once again honored outstanding faculty researchers and departments that met the minimum of 30 percent faculty involvement through the awarding of Gantimpalang Tanso. Gantimpalang Pilak awardees were departments with at least 50% faculty involvement. Those who received Gantimpalang Ginto were departments that reached over 70% faculty involvement in research.

Gawad Tanglaw recognitions were awarded to outstanding mentors for the year. Dr. Maria Virginia Aguilar, Dr. Edwin Lineses, Dr. Johnny Ching, and Dr. Airil Mercurio were chosen for the honor. Dr. Maria Theresa Gochuico was awarded Parangal sa Pagsusuri ng Etikal na Pananaliksik.

The highlight of the Gawad Tala was the Gawad Husay, awarded to the most outstanding faculty researcher of the year. Finalists included Dr. Jimford Tabuyo, CICS Dean Marivic Mitschek, and Dr. Royce Salva but the award ultimately went to Dr. Alrien Dausan.

The two universities further solidified their partnership by signing a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) to co-organize the 3rd International Conference on Research Innovation and Extension to be held this April in DLSU-D.

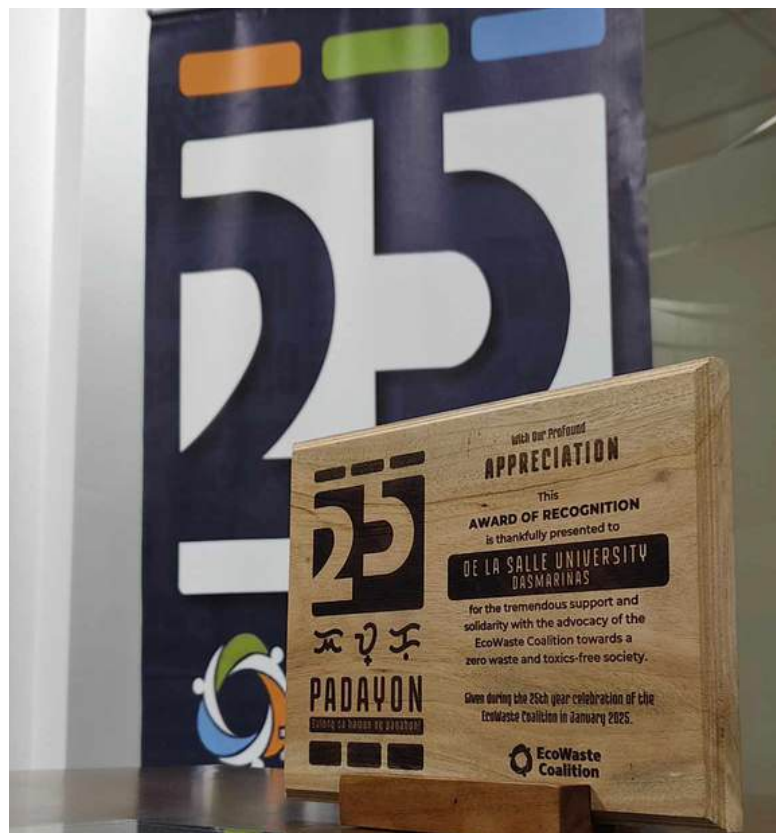


DLSU-D HONORED BY ECOWASTE FOR SUSTAINABLE RESEARCH COLLABORATIONS
