# The ONE DASMA Housing Program/Dorm Scholarship Grants Mechanics

This scholarships awards dormitory accommodation to deserving scholars who intends to have a good quality of education while they are in the scholarship program of DLSU-D.

# **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1. Applicant must be a currently enrolled scholar at De La Salle University-Dasmariñas (DLSU-D).
- 2. Applicant must reside far from the university, requiring 2 to 3 hours of travel to and from campus.
- 3. Applicant must maintain good academic standing and comply with the terms of their scholarship.

## **Application Requirements:**

Applicants must submit the following:

- 1. Fully Accomplished Dorm Scholarship Grant Form (available at the Linkages and Scholarship Office or online).
- 2. Letter of Intent addressed to the Scholarship Officer, explaining why the applicant needs the housing assistance.
- 3. Certificate of Indigency from the barangay or local government unit (LGU).

## **Application Process:**

- 1. Submission of Application Documents:
  - Submit the complete requirements to the Linkages and Scholarship Office (LSO) on or before the posted deadline.
- 2. Screening and Initial Interview:
  - The Scholarship Officer will review applications for completeness and initial qualifications.
  - Qualified applicants will undergo an interview with the Scholarship Officer to assess the following:
    - Academic performance.
    - Financial need and circumstances.
    - Readiness to comply with program guidelines.
- 3. Endorsement to Veverland Corporation:
  - The Scholarship Officer will endorse the names of qualified applicants to Veverland Corporation for final screening.
- 4. Final Interview and Orientation by Veverland Corporation:
  - Endorsed applicants will be invited for a final interview with representatives of Veverland Corporation.
  - Accepted applicants will participate in an orientation session where guidelines, house rules, and reminders will be discussed.

### **Program Expectations:**

- 1. Scholars must comply with all housing program rules and regulations set by Veverland Corporation.
- 2. Scholars are required to maintain good academic performance and submit progress reports to the Scholarship Office every semester.
- 3. Any violations of housing policies or academic probation may result in disqualification from the program.

#### SCHOLAR'S RESPONSIBILITIES BEFORE and AFTER GRADUATION

- 1. The scholar shall follow the general rules and standard procedures of both parties while in the DLSU-D scholarship program.
- 2. The scholar shall religiously follow the Rules and Regulation of the dorm/building for safety and security of everyone.
- 3. The scholar shall regularly communicate with **Verveland Properties**, **Inc.**, coordinator, especially with concern on the amenities and accessibility in the building.
- 4. The recipient shall actively participate in the meetings and activities related to the scholarship program and other related activities by invitation.
- 5. The recipient shall provide updates on his/her personal contact information to **Verveland Properties, Inc.,** and **DLSU-D.**
- 6. Utilities and Association dues for the dormitory will be shouldered by the recipients. Building policies and other administrative guidelines will be followed.
- 7. The responsibilities mentioned above are considered moral obligations of the scholar and should be emphasized during the selection process.

- Application deadlines will be announced through the DLSU-D scholarship website, campus bulletin boards, and LSO channels.
