With the transition to K-12 and the commencement of ASEAN Integration, communication and journalism education is at a crossroads in the Philippines, and as such, schools, scholars and educators in the country are faced by both challenges and opportunities. This was the main point emphasized by DLSU-D's Communication and Journalism Department faculty and Philippine Association of Communication Educators (PACE) President Marco Polo during the Asian Communication and Journalism Societies Forum held from August 21 to 23 in Daejeon City and Seoul City, South Korea.

The forum, organized by the Korean Society for Communication and Journalism, was attended by 50 delegates coming from organizations and institutions that

offer communication and journalism programs from the following countries/territories: Philippines, South Korea, Japan, China, Hong Kong, Cambodia, Thailand, Indonesia, Sri Lanka, India and Singapore. International Communication Association President and former Asian Media Information Center Chairman Dr. Ang Peng Hwa was also in attendance.

Polo represented the Philippines together with officers of the Association of Development Communication Educators and Practitioners-Philippines namely Dr. Rotacio Gravoso and Dr. Pamela Custodio.

In his presentation, Polo also discussed the state of research productivity of communication scholars. Though

publication in international referred journal remains low, there is an increased interest in organizing local and international research conferences in recent years. This will hopefully result in renewed interest in the conduct of research and eventually in the publication of these researches in reputable journals and other scientific publications.

Polo also discussed possible modalities for collaboration with the various associations and institutions present at the forum.
