

Clores tackles papers on LGBT psychology at SCU Indonesia

Psychology Department faculty Ricardo Clores tackled papers on LGBT psychology as part of his arrangement as DLSU-D's exchange faculty to Soegijapranata Catholic University (SCU), Semarang, Central Java, Indonesia on May 1-23, 2016.

Part of the exchange faculty program is to hold a seminar which was spearheaded itself by SCU on May 18, 2016. The seminar themed "Children in Conflict with the Law: Comparative Experiences between the Philippines and Indonesia," was attended by local public officials, faculty members, students of graduate schools of psychology and law, and parents.

Clores shared his paper entitled "A thousand mile journey on what do we

do when children rape and kill other children", which discussed the plight of children termed as juvenile delinquents or children in conflict with the law and what can be done to address the problem. Being an exchange faculty, Clores also conducted several lectures and workshops

on LGBT psychology, psychosocial concerns of children in conflict with the law, multi-cultural psychology with emphasis on Sikolohiyang Pilipino, and writing research in Psychology to graduate and undergraduate students of SCU.
